

# <sub>></sub> Information about application for New Subsidy No. 1 Certification (for guardians of children enrolled in kindergarten)



- If your child is 3 years old or older, the subsidy for early education and childcare fees ("subsidy") for private kindergartens and national kindergartens is paid up to a maximum of 25,700 yen per month.
- To receive the subsidy, you must receive New Subsidy No.1 Certification.
- Kyoto City will reimburse (cashback) the amount after it has been paid to the corresponding kindergartens.
- The subsidy is eligible for the date of application for New Subsidy No.1 Certification onward, so please carefully read the information below and ensure that you complete the application process before starting to use the subsidy.

## 1. Requirements and eligibility for receiving New Subsidy No. 1 Certification

- Those who registered their residence in Kyoto City at the desired date of the beginning of certification validity.
- The desired start day of certification validity must be the day before the child turns full age of 3 or later. (\*1)
- Those who are currently being enrolled or planning to be enrolled in a private or national kindergarten is eligible for New Subsidy No.1 Certification. (\*2)
  - \*1 New Subsidy No.1 Certification can be received from the day before the child turns full age of 3.
  - \*2 In Kyoto City, the following kindergartens are not eligible for private school subsidies (not eligible for New Subsidy No. 1 Certification). To receive free early education and childcare service regarding the following kindergartens, you will need Subsidy No. 1 certification instead of New Subsidy No. 1 Certification. For the latest information on kindergartens and the procedures for Subsidy No.1 Certification, please check the Kyoto City website written in No. 5 on back side of this paper.

(For those who also use kindergarten's after-hours childcare service)

If you meet the following requirements and receive New Subsidy No. 2 or 3 Certification, after-hours childcare service fees will be free up to a maximum amount. If you meet the following requirements, please apply for New Subsidy No. 2 or 3 Certification. (As for the application for New Subsidy No. 2 or 3 Certification, please refer to the Kyoto City website written in No. 5 on the back side.)

After-hours childcare service arrangement differs from kindergartens, so please check with the kindergarten that you are using or planning to use.

\*The above subsidy amounts are for private kindergartens that are eligible for the subsidy or national kindergartens. The subsidy varies depending on the kindergarten or services, so please refer to the Kyoto City website on the back side section 5, for the free early education and childcare services by kindergarten.

### 2. Application Procedures

Please submit the enclosed "<u>Application for the Subsidy for Early Education and Childcare Fees for Child-rearing</u>" to the following address:

Certification validity will begin after the application date (the date on which the application documents are received by Kyoto City). The start date of certification validity cannot be retroactive to before the application date, so please be sure to apply before the start date of use.

\*If you are planning to move to Kyoto City, your certification will be granted after you have completed the procedure for changing your residence registration.



# 3. Subsidy details and payment method (in the case of New Subsidy No. 1 Certification)

As for kindergarten fees, Kyoto City will reimburse (cashback) up to a maximum of 25,700 yen per month after it has been paid to the corresponding kindergartens.

The payment schedule is as follows (3 months' worth of benefits paid in one lump sum every 3 months).

\* This does not include the cost of kindergarten lunch ingredients, transportation fees such as shuttle buses, or uniforms.



### 4. Cases where procedures are required after submitting your application

In the following cases, amendment procedures are required, so please submit the Amendment Application Form. The complete set of Amendment Application Form is available on the Kyoto City website (see 5 below), at each ward office and branch office's Child Nurturing Office, and at each kindergarten.

- 1. When changing your home address (move within the same city) 2. When changing your household composition 3. When withdrawing or declining admission to the childcare facility
- 4. To change your certification category (From New Subsidy No. 1 to New Subsidy No. 2, etc.) 5. To change the bank account for subsidy transferred
- \* If you move outside the city, the certification date in Kyoto City will be available until the day before you move. If you wish to continue using the childcare facility, you must complete the procedures for revoking certification from Kyoto City, and the procedures for free early education and childcare services in the local government area to which you are moving out, by the date of moving.
