- Joined "Powering Past Coal Alliance"



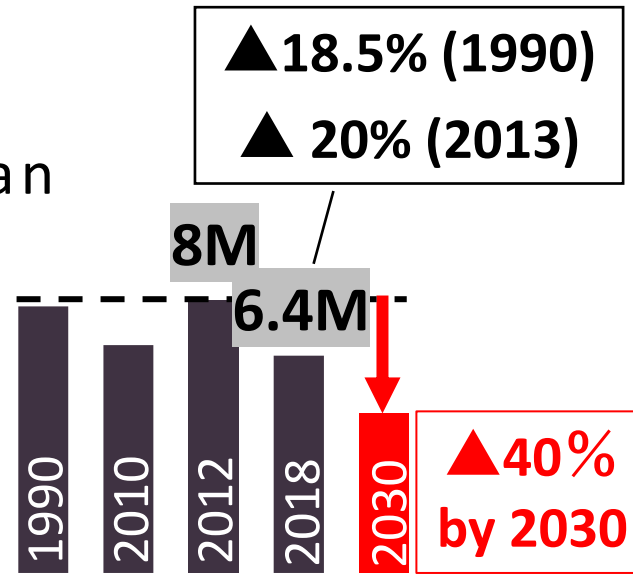
Kyoto's commitment to Net-Zero by 2050

2030 Targets

- Reduce GHG by 40%
- Reach 35% renewable energy
- Double the number of solar power generation installations
