Burnable waste	<p>Food waste Glass items Non-recyclable paper</p>		<p>For burnable waste Collected twice a week Use yellow designated bags for burnable waste</p>
Cans, glass bottles, and PET bottles	<p>Cans Glass bottles PET bottles</p>		<p>For recyclable waste Collected once a week Use the designated transparent bags for recyclable waste</p>
Plastic items	<p>Storage containers Toothbrushes (excluding electric toothbrush handles) CDs / DVDs Cups</p>		<p>For recyclable waste Collected once a week Use the designated transparent bags for recyclable waste</p>
Small metal items / Spray cans	<p>Pots Frying pans * Up to approximately 30 cm in diameter (excluding handles) Spray cans Gas cartridges</p>		<p>Collected once a month Place it in a transparent bag and either attach a label saying "metal" or write "metal" directly on the bag.</p>
Miscellaneous paper	<p>News papers Cardboard Flyers / Catalogs Magazines</p>		<p>Tie with string Place in a paper bag</p>
