## Riding the Kyoto City Bus

Please board from the rear door. You will pay the fare afterwards.

Note: In addition to cash and IC cards, you may also ride using **Subway & Bus 1-Day Pass**, and other Kyoto city travel tickets.

Note: You cannot use QR code payment or tap with credit cards.

**EX100 and EX101 should be boarded from the front. And please pay when you board!**

**Routes**

EX100 Types: Kyoto Sta. → Gion → Kiyomizu-dera Temple → Ginkakuji Temple

EX101 Types: Kyoto Sta. → Gion → Kiyomizu-dera Temple → Umamachi

**Fare**

Ride all day with the Subway & Bus 1-Day Pass

You can also use Cash, or IC Cards

One trip: Adult - 500 yen, Child - 250 yen

Commuter Pass, Coupon Tickets, Senior Citizen Pass, and Welfare Pass cannot be used.

**How to use IC cards**

Tap your card to the IC card panel on the payment machine.

**33** For non-flat fare buses, marked with black text on a white background, that also operate outside the flat fare zone, you must tap your card twice, once when you **get on**, and again when you **get off**.

## When you see your stop coming push the button.

You can see the next bus stop on the display, or you can hear the announcement. When you hear or see that your stop is next, push the button.

**Subway 1-Day Pass**  
(Kyoto City Subway)  
800yen (children half-price)

This pass allows unlimited rides on all Kyoto City subways for one day. Can be purchased from ticket machines for same-day use.
