

8 Jojuji Temple

Many maple trees are planted from the entrance to the inside part, especially when it gets red, the place looks extra beautiful providing a beautiful view.

Access

- ◆ About 5 minutes walk from Kyoto bus "Kokedera Suzumushidera" bus stop.
- ◆ About 15 minutes walk from Hankyu Kamikatsura station.
- ◆ Open hours: 9:00 - 17:00 (closes at 16:30 from December to March)




7 Jizoin

It is surrounded by beautiful bamboo groves and during autumn the leaves provide a beautiful view making it an attraction spot.

Access

- ◆ About 2 minutes walk from Kyoto bus "Kokedera Suzumushidera" bus stop.
- ◆ About 12 minutes walk from Hankyu Kamikatsura station.
- ◆ Open hours: 9:00 - 16:30 (Final Entry at 16:15)
- ◆ Admission fee: adult 500 yen
- ◆ High school student and below 300 yen



6 Saihoji Temple (Kokedera)

This temple is known by the name "Kokedera" (Moss Temple) due to the beauty of the moss spreading throughout the garden.

Access

- ◆ About 3 minutes walk from Kyoto bus "Kokedera Suzumushidera" bus stop.
- ◆ About 15 minutes walk from Hankyu Kamikatsura station.
- ◆ About 15 minutes walk from Hankyu Matsuoishima station.
- ◆ Visiting Saihoji requires advance reservation with round-trip postcard. For details, please visit the official website. <http://saihoji-kokedera.com/>




5 Matsuo Taisha Shrine

It is one of the oldest shrine in Kyoto. The main hall is designated as an important cultural property (building).

Access

- ◆ About 3 minutes walk from Hankyu Matsuoishima station.
- ◆ About 5 minutes walk from the Kyoto city bus "Matsuoishimae" bus stop.
- ◆ Open hours: 9:00-16:00 on weekdays and Saturdays
- ◆ 9:00 - 16:30 on Sundays and Holidays (Entrance fee is required for Garden and Museum - adult 500 yen, students 400 yen, children 300 yen)



4 Kegonji Temple (Suzumushidera)

From this temple you can hear the sound of bell crickets throughout the year. The chanting while listening to the sound of bell crickets is very popular.

Access

- ◆ About 2 minutes walk from the Kyoto bus "Kokedera Suzumushidera" bus stop.
- ◆ About 15 minutes walk from Hankyu Kamikatsura station.
- ◆ Open hours: 9:00-17:00 (The final entry is at 16:50)
- ◆ Admission fee: 500 yen for adults
- ◆ Child (4 years old to middle school student) 300 yen
- ◆ ※ with sweets




3 Horiuji Temple

This temple has a long history. Its name has been in the classics such as "Makuranosoushi (The Pillow Book)" and "Heike Monogatari (The Tale of the Heike)".

Access

- ◆ About 5 minutes walk from Hankyu Arashiyama station.
- ◆ About 10 minutes walk from Keifuku Arashiyama station.
- ◆ About 20 minutes walk from JR Saga Arashiyama station.
- ◆ Open hours: 9:00-17:00




2 Hozu River

The renowned scenery of Hozu Gorge is wonderful spot. It is famous for the Hozu River descent and the truck train.

Access

- ◆ Hozugawa (near Togetsukyo Bridge)
- ◆ A few minutes walk from Hankyu and Keifuku Arashiyama station.
- ◆ About 10 minutes walk from JR Saga Arashiyama station.
- ◆ About 20 minutes walk from JR Saga Arashiyama station.
- ◆ Use Sagano Tourist Railway (Sagano Trolley Train) Truck Hozukyo station



1 Senkoji Temple

This temple was built in the early Edo period by relocating it from Saga.

Access

- ◆ About 30 minutes walk from Hankyu Arashiyama station.
- ◆ About 40 minutes walk from JR Saga Arashiyama station.
- ◆ About 50 minutes walk from Keifuku Arashiyama station.
- ◆ Open hours: 10:00-16:00
- ◆ Entrance fee: 400 yen
