

This temple was founded in 784 and is currently headed by a German priest. With the mountain cherry blossoms in spring, the summer camellia and lotus flowers in summer among others, the beauty of flowers can be enjoyed.

7 Fukujoji Temple

Access
City bus "Sannomiya Kaido" bus stop, 6 minutes

Remains of the long-ago Asuka Period are preserved here.

6 Katagiharahaji Temple

Katagiharahaji Temple, built in the mid-7th century, is said to have been destroyed in the early Heian period. In the present park, Historic Site Park, the foundations of the ruins have been restored.



Access
3 minutes walk from City bus "Sannomiya Kaido" bus stop

Its legend of the chasing out of demons has been passed down from old times.

5 Katagihara Sannomiya Jinja Shrine

Legend has it that in the middle of the Heian period, a demon on Kyoto's Oe Mountain that caused great fear to the people was conquered by being alcohol to drink until it passed out drunk. Katagihara Sannomiya Shrine is said to have been built to enshrine the deities of alcohol, courage, and the mountain.



Access
3 minutes walk from City bus "Sannomiya Kaido" bus stop

Designated as a National Historic Site.

4 Tenna-no-mori Kofun Tomb

Tenna-no-mori Kofun Tomb, constructed in the second half of the 4th century in the highest ranking keyhole mound style, is believed to be the grave of the powerful family that ruled from the right bank of Katsura River.



Access
Just next to City bus, walk from Hankyu Katsura Station bus stop 20 minutes

It houses many Cultural Properties

3 Hongwanji Nishiyama Betsuin (Nishiyama Gobou)

The temple gate is located on the Saninkaido old highway route. In the spring, cherry blossoms, in the fall the autumn maple leaves and large ginkgo trees are splendid. [Kyoto City Cultural Property] the main temple [National Important Cultural Property] main temple screen painting "Mistral and pine", "Peony and cherry blossom" by Tokuriki Zensou (not for public view)



Access
3 minutes walk from City bus, Keihan bus "Katsuraekikigashirauchi" bus stop 5 minutes walk from Hankyu Katsura Station

One of the sacred temples of the Rokuji-zo Meguri pilgrimage of six temples

2 Jizoji Temple (Katsurajizo)

Located on the old Saninkaido route. The main deity of the temple, Jizo Bosatsu, was said in the Heian period to have gone to and from the netherworld. The Jizo Bosatsu of Jizoji is said to have been carved from one piece of wood by Ono No Takamura.



Access
Just in front of City bus, Keihan Kyoto Kotsu bus "Katsura Shobo-sho-mae" bus stop 7 minutes walking from Hankyu Katsura station

Katagihara is included in the "Buildings and landscapes that mark Kyoto" designation.

Katagihara Honjin (Tamamura Family Residence)

A daimyo class official lodging, the only one remaining in the city.



Access
About 8 minutes walk from City bus, Keihan Kyoto Kotsu bus "Katsura Rikyu-mae" bus stop About 20 minutes walk from Hankyu Katsura Station

Prospered as a post town, on the old Saninkaido highway route

Kobatake River

In 1575, Akechi Mitsuhide used this location as a supply site during the Tanba conquest, constructing reservoirs and waterways. On the Kobokabe River, with a monument commemorating the Loyalist Martyrs, and nearby Koizumi Nizaeon ruins established in many villages, one remaining in Katagihara.

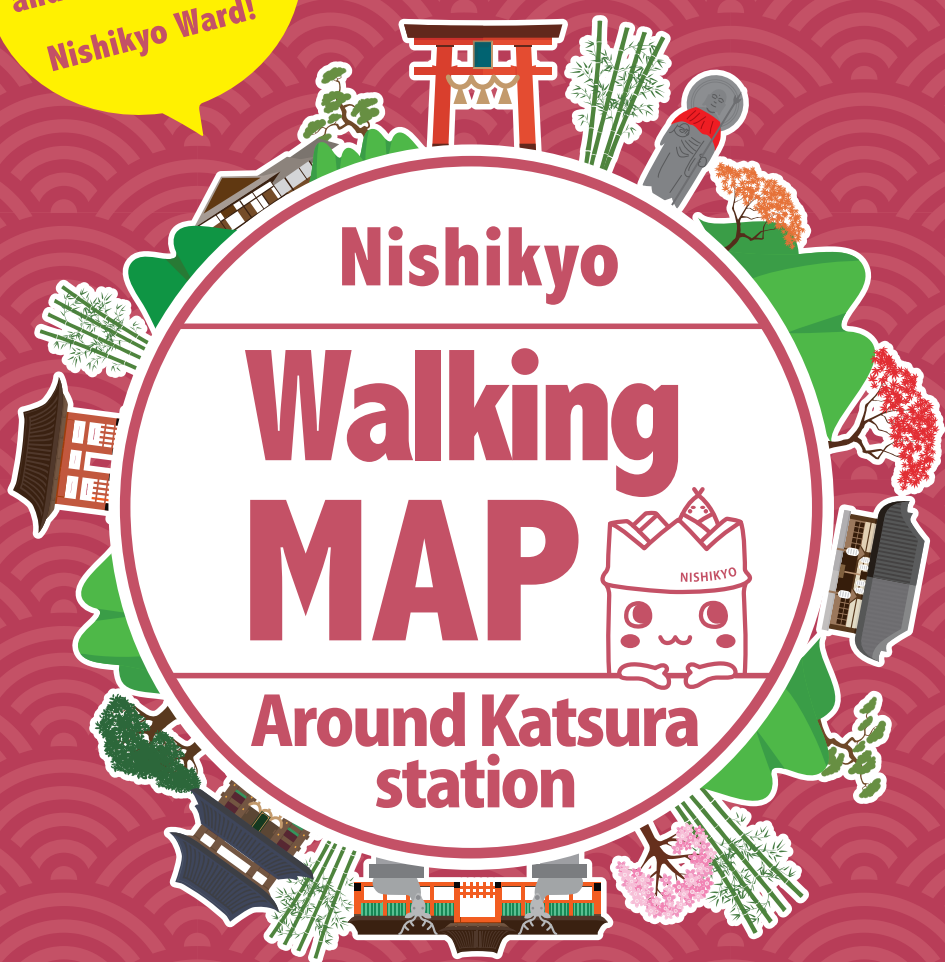
