

Bus & Subways in Kyoto City

In Kyoto, the city-run public bus and subway services will cover most travel needs. The city can be enjoyed to its utmost using these two key transportation systems efficiently. Bus: the fare is 220 yen within a designated central area in the city. The fare increases as the bus travels further outside the designated area. **Subway:** two subway lines in the city: Karasuma Line (north to south) and Tozai Line (east to west). Minimum fare to

Discount bus/subway tickets: The City Bus One-day Pass covers most of the central fixed fare area. It allows for unlimited use on the same day.

Kyoto Sightseeing One (or Two-day) Pass: all city bus and subway lines are covered. ¥1,000/day, ¥2,000/2 days
